

16C/30C, Proper Usage as 16C Registry Rate

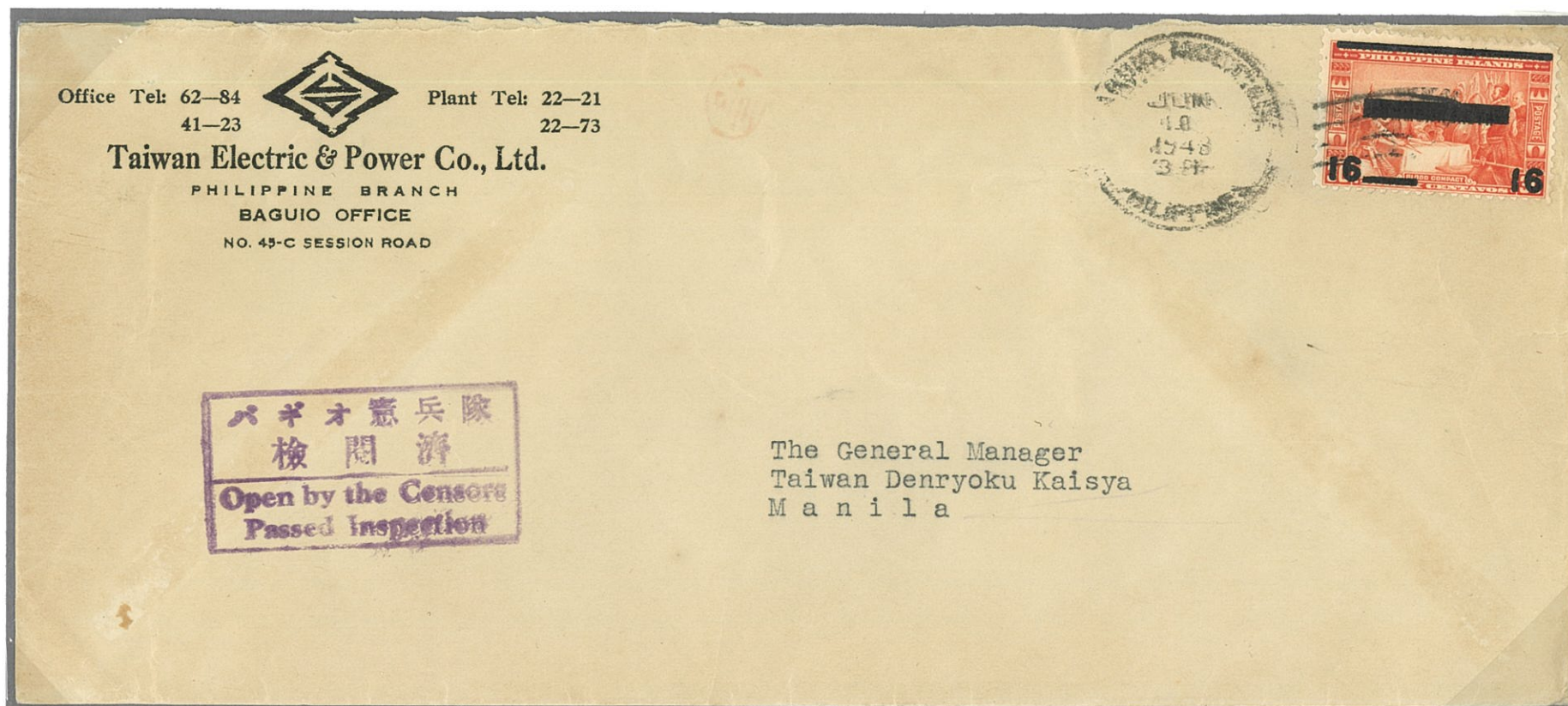
The registry rate was reduced 12C from 16C on Mar. 1, 1943 and therefore proper usages of 16C/30C stamp as 16C registry rate were rarely encountered because the rate was effective only for 49 days (From Jan. 11, 1943 to Feb.28, 1943) .



Feb. 1, 1943, Single First Class Registered Mail, Manila Circulating

Franked with a 5C/1P First Anniv. Phil. Executive Commission Stamp as first class mail rate and a 16C/30C provisional stamp as 16C registry rate. Properly censored at Manila

16C/30C, Single Franking, Triple First Class Mail



Jun. 10, 1943, Triple First Class Mail, Baguio City to Manila

Franked with a 16C/30C stamp for the 15C triple first class mail rate. Overpaid 1C. Censored at Baguio
