

2C+1C, Proper Commercial Usage





Copy of backside (90%)

Dec. 11, 1942, Christmas Greeting Card-sized Mail, Manila Circulating

Franked with a 2C+1C stamp for payment of proper 2C discount rate instead of 5C which was applied in Dec. 1942 &1943.

Posted: Dec. 11, 1942 Manila

Transit: Dec. 22, 1942 Manila, Second Notice but unclaimed


Transit: Dec. 23, 1942 Return to Manila Post Office (Manila Carrier-in-charge Postmark)

Finally, unclaimed and return to the sender on Dec. 31, 1942.

Scarce Postmark: Only known "MANILA POST OFFICE / CARRIER-IN- CHARGE NO.3" postmark

Properly censored at Manila

5C+1C, Proper Commercial Usage



Feb. 17, 1943, Single First Class Mail, Lingayen Pangasinan to Manila
Affixed with a 5C+1C stamp for proper 5C first class mail rate.
Most of Food Production Campaign Semi-Postal stamps were consumed as philatelic use and less than 5 proper commercial usages were confirmed.
