
## **Proof**

Considered as a trial design, similar but deferent from issued stamp, such as blurred printing, smaller "1943", "Postage" (almost missing) and "size of Rizal monument". Confirmed only in 17C denomination and most of them were with hand drawn blue green ink lines but an example without the pen marking exists.

The existence of the proof was known at that time and some of them were consumed as the philatelic use. This is an example of a philatelic use on the FDC of First Anniversary of the Independence stamps.
