

A set of three perforated stamps was issued on Feb. 17, 1944, the memorial day of 72<sup>nd</sup> anniversary of the execution of Father Jose Burgos.

On Apr. 17, 1944, a set of three imperforate stamps was issued. These stamps were issued as regular stamps, but it is reasonable to treat as commemoratives because these were released in limited quantities. Perforated stamps and imperforate stamps were printed from the same plate and same varieties occurred in both.

**Quantity:** 5C Rizal: 500,000 (Perf.) / 200,000 (Imperf.) , 12C Burgos: 300,000 (Perf.) / 200,000 (Imperf.) , 17C Mabini: 200,000 (Perf.) / 200,000 (Imperf.)
