

16 kinds of regular stamps were released on 6 separate occasions as follows:

- Apr. 1, 1943 2C & 5C stamps
- Jun. 7, 1943 1C, 4C & 1P stamps
- Jul. 14, 1943 6C, 10C, 12C & 16C stamps
- Aug. 16, 1943 20C, 21C & 15C stamps
- Sep. 16, 1943 2P (First Print) stamp
- Apr. 10, 1944 2P (Second Print) & 5P (First & Second Print) stamps

All stamps were printed in Japan at "Naikaku Insatsu Kyoku" or "Cabinet Bureau of Printing" in 4 different designs; **Nipa Hut** (1C, 4C & 20C), **Girl Planting Rice** (2C, 6C & 25C), **Mt. Fuji & Mt. Mayon Volcanos** (5C, 10C, 21C & 1P) and **Moro Vinta** (12C, 16C, 2P & 5P).
