
## Usages of Japan Printed Regular Stamps 5C Provincial Usage



Sep. 3, 1943,
Double First Class Mail,
Dansalan, Lanao to Manila
Franked with two 5C regular
stamps for proper double first
class mail rate.


Censored in Dansalan, Lanao with Garret Type IC7 censor mark.

The censorship had been continued in towns in the Mindanao Island including Dansalan, Lanao after the use of censor marks had been discontinued on June 30, 1943 by the executive order.

**Turned Cover:** The envelope was re-used one. Original cover was Manila to Dansalan cover dated May 14, 1943 with single franking of 5C/6C provisional stamp (second overprinting)

Scarce Censor Mark: The Dansalan Garret Type IC7 censor marks were known in less than five examples.

## 5C Strip of Five, Triple Registered Mail



## Jan. (date unknown), 1944, Triple First Class Registered mail, Rosario, Cavite to Manila

Franked with a strip of five 5C regular stamps together with a 2C provisional stamp for proper 27C single first class registered mail rate. All stamps are with "K.P." hand-stamped and "K.P." means "Official Business"

Posted: Jan., 1944 Rosario, Cavite

Transit: Jan.18. 22, 1944 San Pablo City (Transit marking of Cavite City on verso)

Arrived: Jan. 20, 1944 Manila (marking of Registry Section, Manila on verso)

Scarce K.P. hand-stamp: This is the only known K.P. hand-stamp used in Rosario, Cavite.
