A set of three provisional stamps was issued on **Apr. 7, 1943; 2C stamp** covered for first class postal card rate, **5C/6C stamp** covered for first class mail rate and **16C/30C stamp** covered for no relevant postal rate at the time of issue (originally planned to cover registry fee but it was reduced from 16C to 12C from Mar.1, 1943). These stamps were strictly restricted in use of official mail only.
