

DERECHOS DE FIRMA (FEES FOR SIGNATURE)

TELEGRAPH RECEIPT

January 29, 1881: Telegraph Receipt from Manila to Boston, Massachusetts, USA, via Suez Valentia. Telegraph containing 16 words and charged at 52-pesos and 21-centimos de peso. Combination of postal, fiscal and telegraph stamp usage, each cancelled with Telegraph Hole Punch.



50 pesos – Ten Derecho de Firma 5 pesos stamp issue of 1864-1865 (Warren W-35)

2 pesos – Derecho de Firma 10 peseta stamp issue of 1873-1874 (Warren W-48) (1 peseta = 1/5 peso)

5 centavos – Allegorical 25 centimos de peseta postal issue of 1874 (Scott #49) (1 centimo = 1/5 centavo)

6 centavos – Three 2 centimos de peso Surcharge Era stamp issue of 1881 (Scott #112)

10 centavos – Telegrafos 2 Reales stamp issue of 1881 (Edifil #8A) (20 reales = 1 peso)
