DERECHO JUDICIAL (JUDICIAL FEE)

1865

Issued for use in Cuba, Porto Rico and the Philippines. This was the last issue of Derecho Judicial stamps for use in the three Colonies. Thereafter, separate stamps were issued for the Philippines. However, the stamps issued for the Spanish Colonies in 1856 and 1865 remained in use in the Philippines until at least as late as 1869. The remaining stamp stocks were handstamped 'Habilitado po la Nacion' in 1869.



Four stamps from this series are known as having been used in the Philippines, as follows: 1/2r Blue (W-26), 1r Black (W-27), 2r Grey-Lilac (W-28), and 5r Brown (W-29).
