
1874 ISSUE

Upon abdication of Spain's King Amadeus on February 11, 1873, a provisional Republic was established. As a result, in June 1874, stamps of a new allegorical design of the Republic were issued in the Philippines. The stamp values in centavos de peseta and the postal rates remained the same as those in 1872. Printed in Spain.
