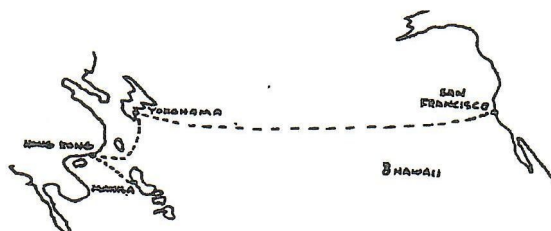

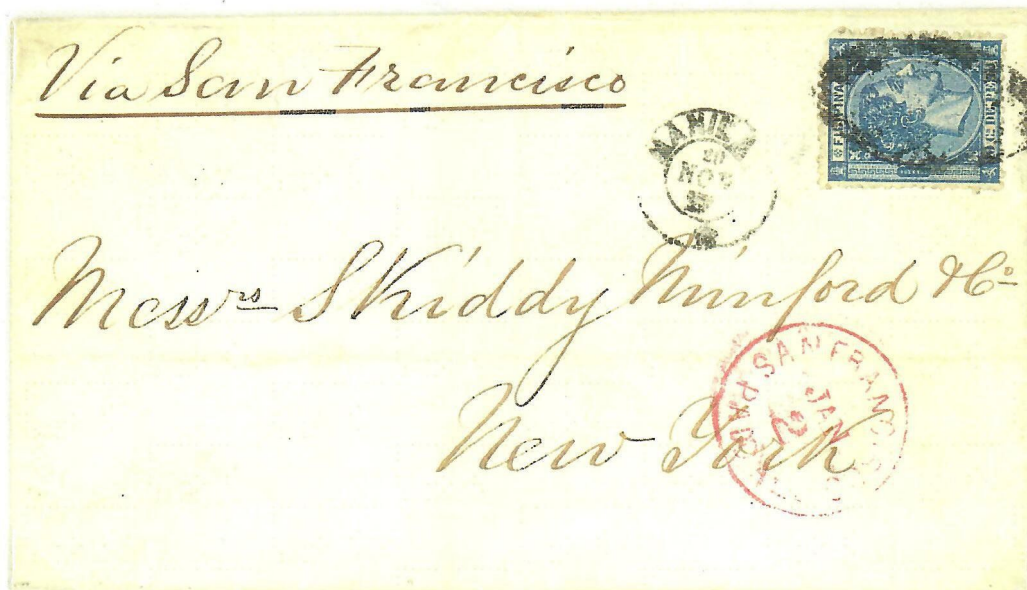
## OVERSEAS POSTAL RATE

## VIA PACIFIC MAIL STEAMSHIP COMPANY PACKET SERVICE

American PMSSC packets commenced U.S. Government subsidized mail service between San Francisco and Hong Kong, via Yokohama, on January 1, 1867, through 1875. Some Manila to U.S. mail connected with this service at Hong Kong or Yokohama. After 1875, PMSSC ships continued to carry Philippine mail, via Hong Kong and Yokohama.
