## EARLIEST REGISTRATION HANDSTAMP TYPE

Beginning in 1865, a handstamp was applied to mail when it was registered.



First handstamp type. Used in the Philippines between 1865-1883. Applied only at the Manila post office.

## EARLIEST KNOWN USE OF STAMPED AND REGISTERED MAIL FROM THE MARIANA ISLANDS

This cover is one of four covers known of the earliest stamped <u>and</u> registered mail of the Spanish Mariana Islands — all dated September 28, 1877. The Mariana Islands were postally administered by the Spanish Philippines at that time. All mail between the Mariana Islands and Manila was posted at the <u>interior</u> rate. On Mariana Islands mail, the "CERTIF" marking was applied at the Manila post office.
