OVERSEAS RATE TO SPAIN

On November 9, 1897, Ricardo Rey, Administrator General (under the Governor-General), Manila, issued Spanish Royal Circular No. 13, which revised the postal rates and procedures for internal mail and overseas mail to Spain and colonies. The single-weight overseas rate to Spain was reduced from 10 centavos to 6 centavos.
