17c National Heroes Regular Issue, Perforated

Printed by rotogravure, on glazed newsprint by one of the printing plants operating under the aegis of manila Shimbun-Sha, Printing Division, Manila in plates of 400 subjects divided into panes of 100 stamps (10x10), without any marginal markings. At the time of issue, the Bureau of Communications announced that this was a Regular Issue, not a Commemorative Issue. The 17c stamp (featuring Apolinario Mabini) paid the combined First Class Letter rate (5c) and Registration Fee (12c). The day of issue coincided with the 72nd anniversary of the 1872 execution by garrotting of three Filipino priests, Fathers Jose Burgos, Mariano Gomez and Jacinto Zamora.
