FALL OF BATAAN AND CORREGIDOR, SECOND ANNIVERSARY

5c ON 20c ULTRAMARINE

US 20c Moro Vinta and Clipper Airmail Stamp issue of 1941 overprinted by the Bureau of Printing in Manila with black deleting bars, obliterating the words "UNITED STATES OF AMERICA / COMMONWEALTH OF THE PHILIPPINES" on the bottom and surcharged to 5c as First Class Mail letter rate. Issued to commemorate the Second Anniversary of the Fall of Bataan and Corregidor; also contemporarily called the 'Third Bataan Issue'.

Printed in plates of 200 subjects, set up in four Post Office panes of 50 stamps (5 x 10). Each pane has one plate number at the top or the bottom. One plate numbers per value: 146129 (5c on 20c) and 146130 (12c on 60c).
