

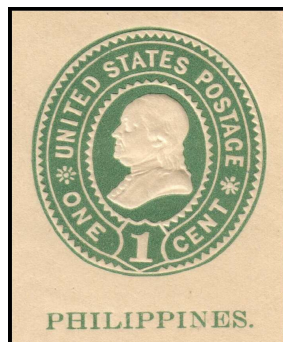

PLIMPTON ENVELOPES

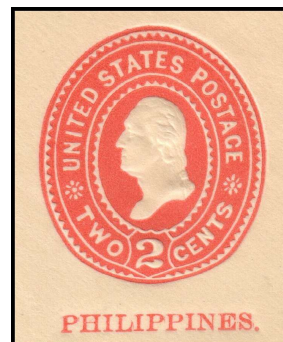
This series of envelopes were produced from the United States Pre-Stamped Envelope series of 1899, produced by the Plimpton & Morgan Company of Hartford, Connecticut, USA. The word "PHILIPPINES" was added beneath the indicia, mostly in the same colour as the indicia, other than three issues on which the overprinted is printed in red. All the Plimpton envelopes were printed on laid paper with "US POD '99" Watermark (UPSS Type 13).

A number of envelopes from this series exist with a "Francisco Gonzales" corner card. These were produced by special request through the Post Office and properly ordered as per US POD rules, and are listed by Scott as Post Office produced envelopes. They were obtained for stamp dealer John Zug, of Everett, Washington, who advertised them for sale to collectors. Although they were produced in small quantities, they were sold into the philatelic market where unused envelopes are not rare. Additional privately produced corner cards were also printed and are noted accordingly.

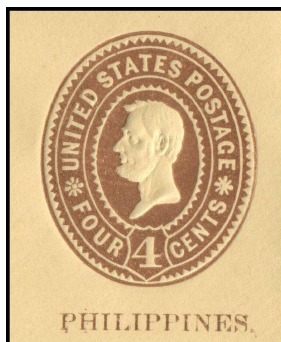

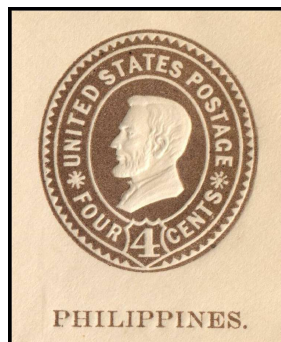

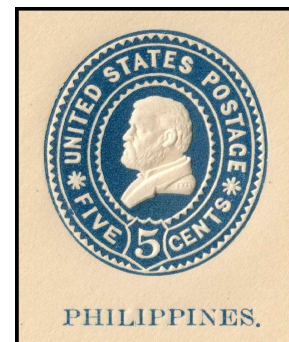

KNIFE TYPES

The term “Knife” refers to the shape of an envelope, more specifically the shape of the paper before it is folded. Knife is the technical term for the cutters of the machine by which the envelope blanks are cut out. In philately, it is principally used to denote the varieties in shape of the United States envelopes, where the back shows several varieties in the cutting of the flaps.

Fortunately, there are not as many Knife variations on the US pre-stamped envelopes that were overprinted for use in the Philippines. Generally, these are classified as “low back” or “high back” types, differentiated by the top section on the reverse side of the envelope as detailed in the following Knife Types.

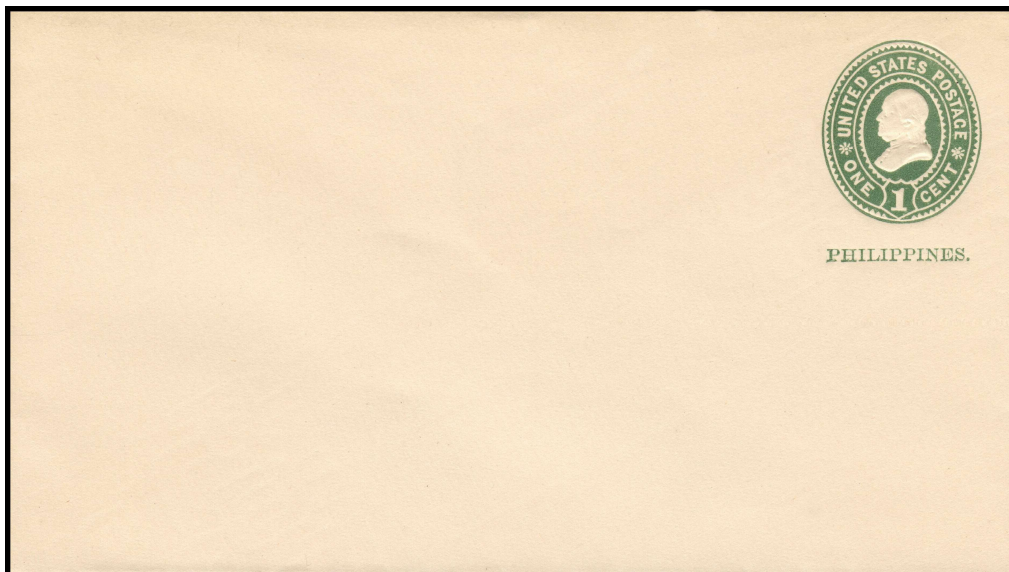

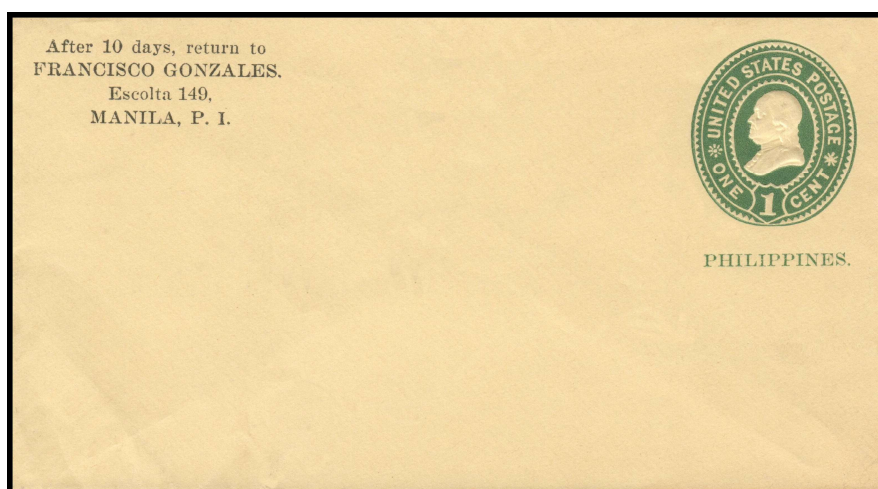
U1B (Knife UPSS 54 - Low Back) and U1C (Knife UPSS 57 - High Back)

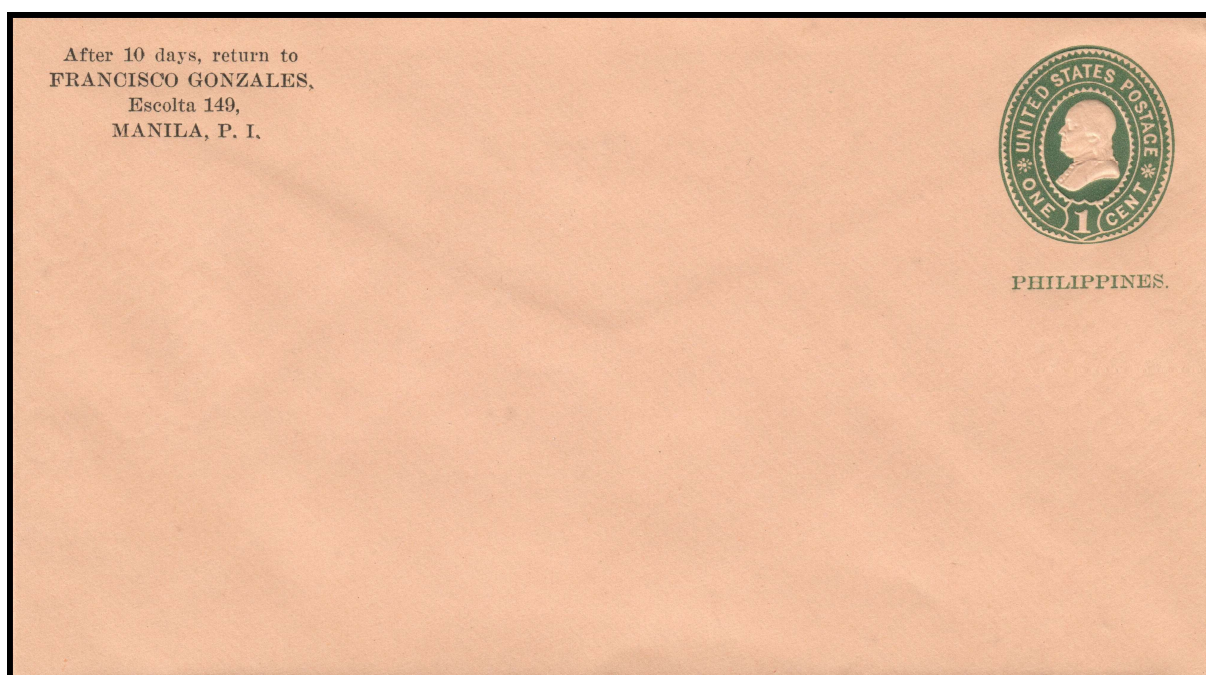

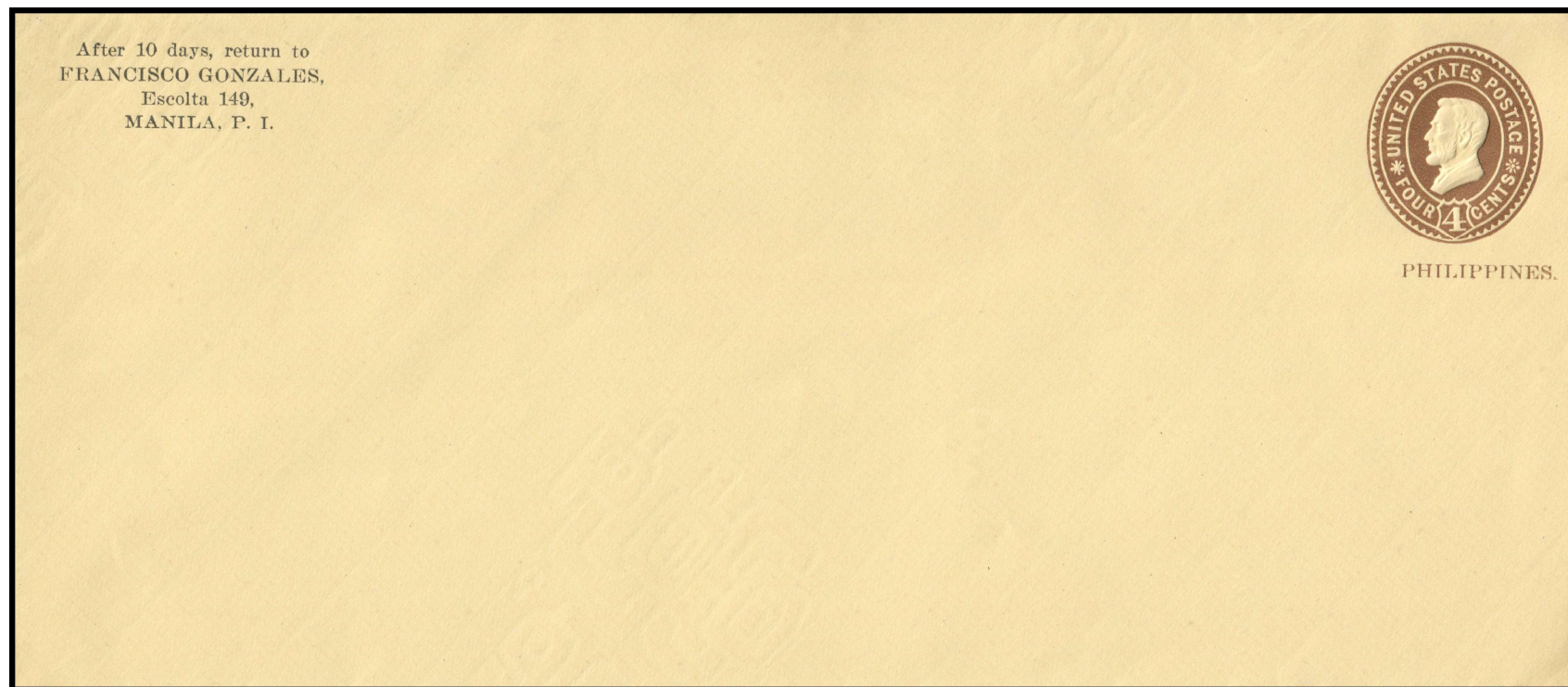
