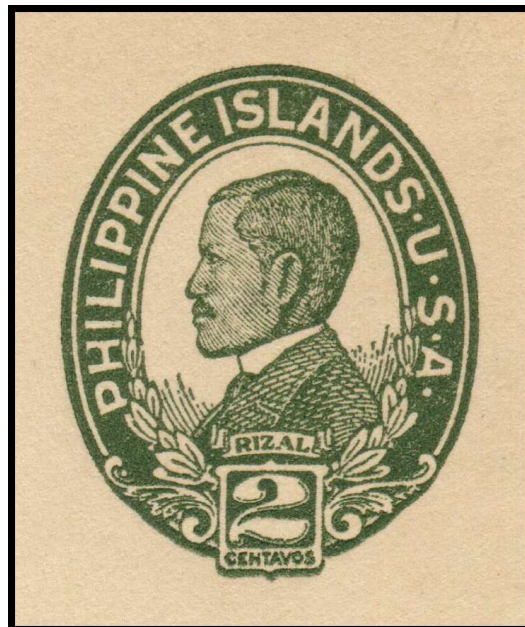


**POSTAL STATIONERY OF THE PHILIPPINES

2c JOSE RIZAL ENVELOPES**

A locally produced 2-Centavos envelope was printed in Manila and placed on sale on 5 April 1927. Issued in shades of green to dark green with non-embossed indicia on locally procured envelopes. Envelopes with corner card printed in green was designed to mimic the format of the previous issue. Additionally, envelopes exist with “Money Order / Giro Postal” imprint in green on bottom left of envelope.

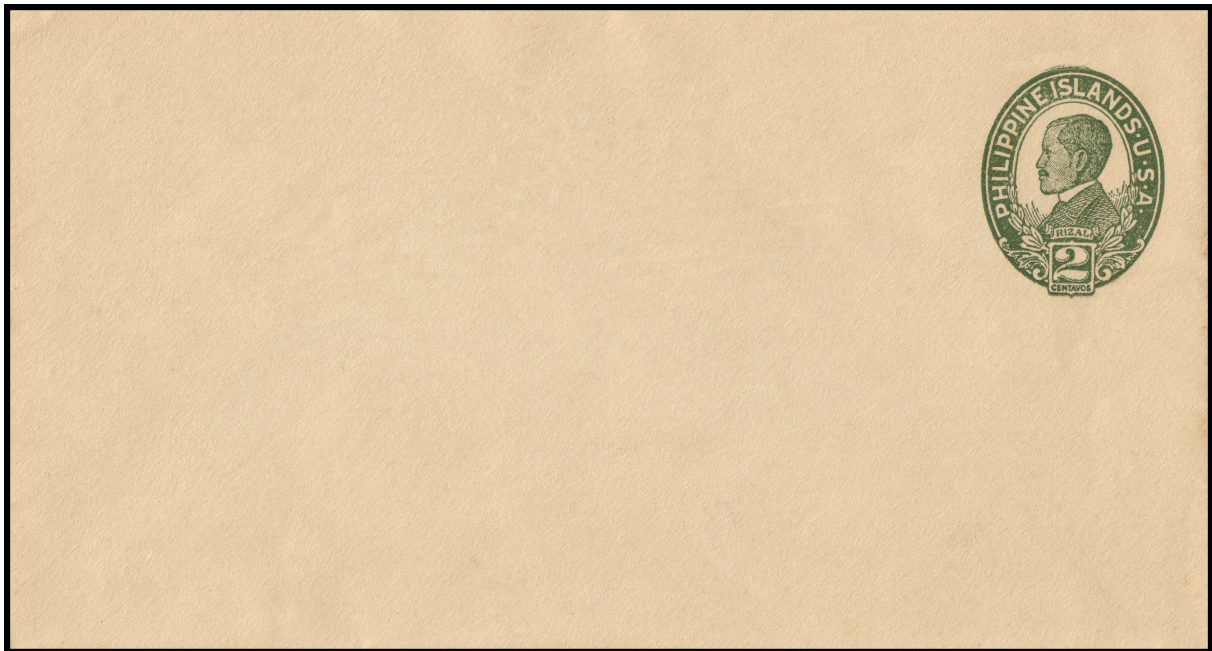

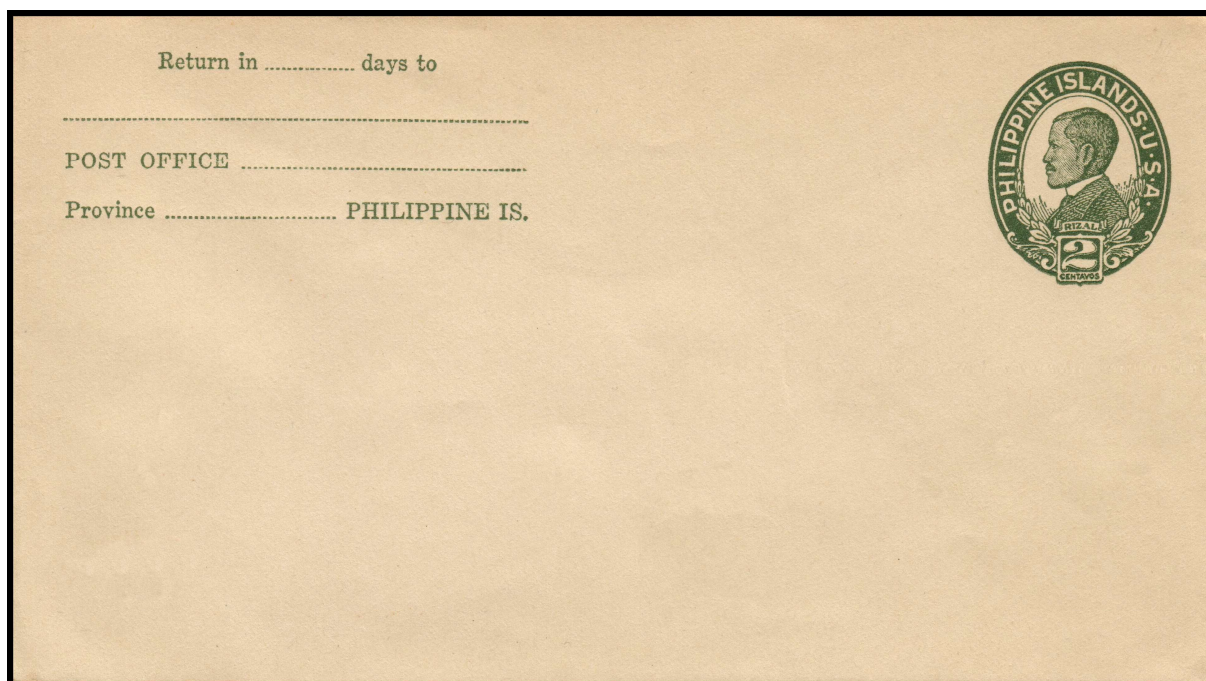

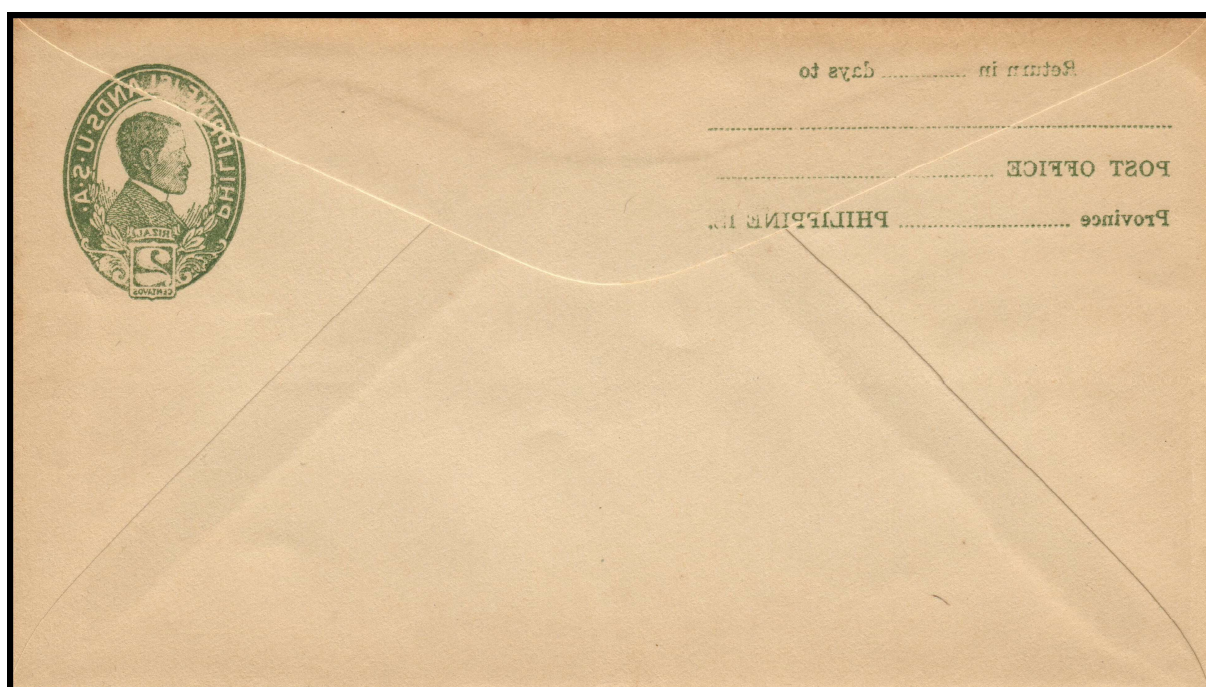
### 2c Green (Rizal) on Locally Procured Envelopes

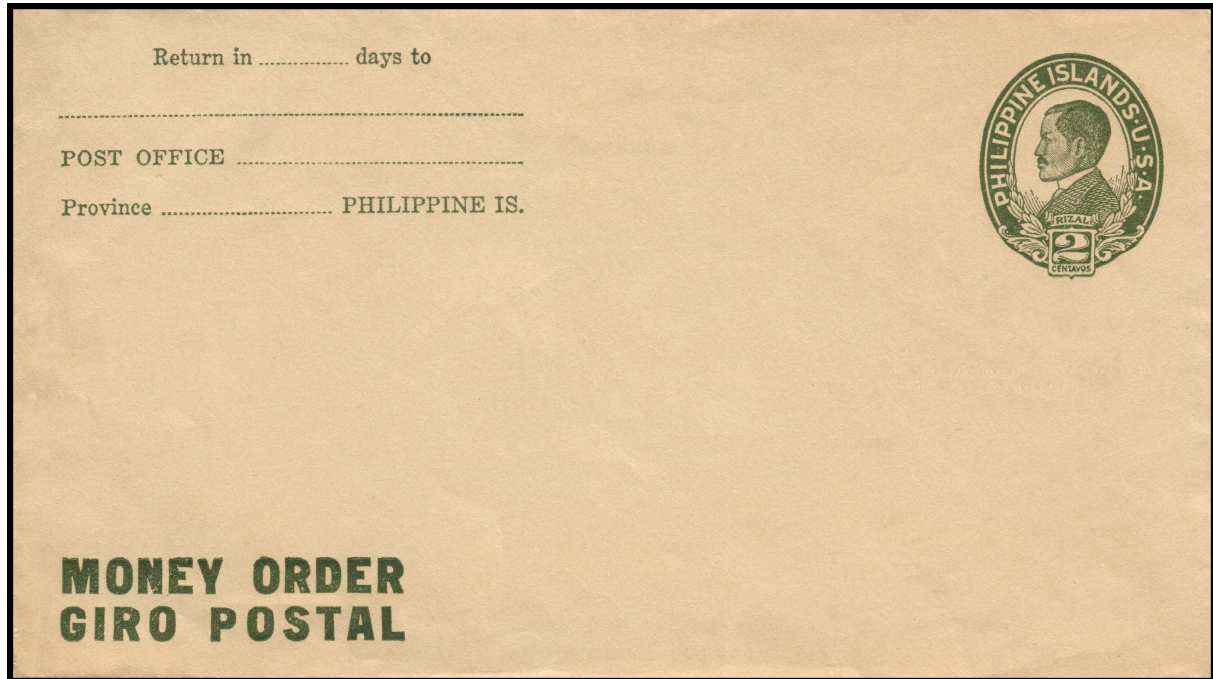
