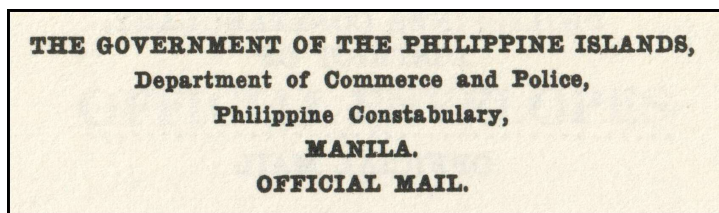

**CORNER CARD TYPE 4**



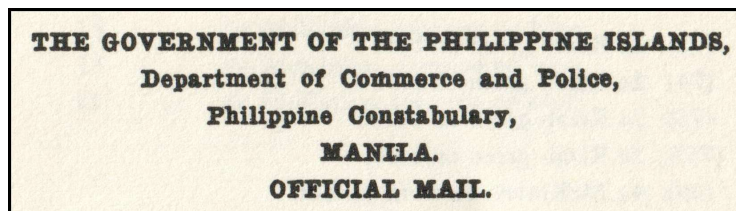

“P” aligned under “m” of “Department”

UPSS-OB30 to UPSS-OB39

Type 4 corner card was printed on envelopes of the series of 1908 and issued around 1911. The corner card was locally printed in black with corresponding “O.B.” overprint on the indicia.

**CORNER CARD TYPE 4A**



CC-4a

“P” aligned under “r” of “Department”

UPSS-OB40 to UPSS-OB43

Type 4a corner card was printed on envelopes of the series of 1908 and issued around 1913. Similar to Type 4 but without the “O.B.” overprint on the indicia. The alignment on row three varies slightly where the words are shifted left slightly, causing “P” of “Philippine” to show under “r” of “Department” instead of being under the “m” of “Department” as in the Type 4 printing.
